

The Rally Cross at Conrad's on Sunday, March 19, 2017, will be run as a regular BAC Rally Cross 2016/2017 season format. However some changes have been added to fit Conrad Quarry.

Please follow directional cones to Registration and Waiver signing. From Registration you will be directed to trailer parking and competitor parking. **Please do Not drive around the quarry, go directly to the site only!**

The course will be approx. 2 minutes long. Cars will be starting at the top of the minute, and we will have up to 2 cars on the course at the same time. The Starter will have a radio.

Please be aware that we will have stations set up throughout the course with Red Flags, please keep an eye on these stations while competing. When you see the Red Flag waving, stop safely and return to start. The worker waving the flag will be trying to make eye contact with you to ensure you take notice and slow/stop safely.

If you are not the cause of the red flag, you shall receive a re-run.

VOLUNTEERS are needed to man these stations and pick up fallen pylons, please do Not wear red clothing. Safety vests will be worn as another notice to drivers you are there. Radios will be provided to contact the Finisher when a pylon(s) had been hit.

Unfortunately there are NO SPECTATORS, but please come out and volunteer! (contact Cathy Partridge if interested. Email: vp@bluenoseautosport.ca)

Please note, if not enough volunteers arrive, competitors will be required to take turns to work a station.

DO NOT STOP for cones that are down. If you're competing and come across a cone that is down, continue your run. After you stop in the stop box, tell the Finish vehicle that a cone is down and you did not hit it. There will be a radio in the vehicle that we will communicate with the course worker.

Conrad Brothers have been wonderful to us and the rally community. Please be on your best behaviour while on their property. We ask that everybody be on site by 10AM the latest and prepare to spend the entire day on site. **There will be a portable toilet on site.**

Competitors will need to provide on Rally day:

- \$20 per driver
 - MUST BE A MEMBER OF AN ATLANTIC REGION MOTORSPORT CLUB (<http://www.armsinc.ca> [1])
 - driver's licence
 - vehicle registration (if the vehicle is road licensed).
 - if the owner of the vehicle is not listed as the driver or passenger, a written authorization from the owner of the vehicle is required.
 - for any participant (driver or passenger) under the age of majority (i.e. 18), a written permission signed by a parent or guardian.
- **No part of the this event will take place on public roads, so your car does not need to be street licensed or insured****

****Please bring your own helmet, we would like to reserve our loaner helmets for new drivers and passengers only, Thank you!****
