Dear rallyists,

In the summer of 2020, we informed you of our difficult decision to postpone the New Scotland Road Rally (NSRR), originally scheduled for September 2020 due to the pandemic. Six months on from our original date, life has still not returned to normal, further variants of the virus are appearing regularly, travel restrictions are still in place (and, in many instances, have been extended or strengthened) and concerns of public health are still foremost in our minds. Our predictions suggest it will be nearly impossible to conduct a successful NSRR in June 2021.

With regret, we today inform you of our decision to indefinitely postpone the NSRR until our global situation returns to some semblance of normalcy. Please accept our apologies for the removal of this event from your motorsport calendars.
